I present to you in writing a brief version of what I presented to you two weeks ago in my homily regarding the new Donald E. Walker Stewardship Foundation.

Donald Walker was a lifelong parishioner at St. Patrick's and worked hard to build his wealth. However, he did not spend it on himself but desired a more lofty goal: support of his Church. After establishing a 30-year trust that supported priestly vocations, the assets were to be given to the parish. Many thanks to Mr. Paul Nordquist, who managed the trust for those 30 years.

Mr. Walker's trust was turned over to us in July with a value of \$2.2 million. After extensive consultation with the parish and finance councils, we determined to establish this foundation for the support of our mission. That is, the money is not for paying utility bills nor for maintenance and repair. Rather, Mr. Walker's desire was that it promote vocations. Since vocations are the fruit of evangelization, the income from the foundation will be used to support our evangelization efforts through providing materials, staff, retreat experiences and support to seminarians from North Platte.

To this end, the councils approved an investment policy that states that the foundation is for the long-term support of evangelization. The Finance Council oversees investments in a diversified portfolio and under the management of a professional advisor. Spending is limited to 3–5% annually and additional growth is revinvested, increasing the value over time. The principal (the invested assets that produce income) cannot be spent except in emergency circumstances and only after several layers of approval. The donated real estate income will be reinvested into the principal and the real estate managed by a professional firm. Future donated assets are converted to cash and invested into the principal.

We are happy to share the entire investment policy to anyone who asks or answer any further questions on the foundation. I look forward to working with staff, the councils and other groups to begin providing additional evangelization benefits in our parish in the near future.


